Ask Father Peter



Question: Some people hold hands during *the Lord's Prayer*, while others hold their hands out like the priest. Is there a prescribed *posture* for the *Our Father?*

Answer: Yes. The **orans posture** is the posture of the priest during certain parts of the Mass, including the Our Father. He stands with his hands out, palms up and elbows bent. <u>This posture is meant for celebrants ONLY.</u>

As well, the Holy See stated that holding hands 'is a liturgical gesture introduced spontaneously but on personal initiative; it is not in the rubrics' . . . For this reason, no one can be required to hold hands during the Our Father" (161). The appendix notes that the practice of holding hands during the Our Father is "discouraged."

IHMP is Registered with Sarcan's Drop n' Go program!


During Lent, the proceeds we get from recycling donations will go towards our Food Bank initiative!

- 4. Place all your labeled bags/boxes in the designated area & leave!

YOUTH CHOIR PRACTICE


