Dear Pastors and friends of LIFE,

As you probably know, the request from Saskatchewan Pro-Life Association to have May proclaimed as Pro-Life Month in Saskatchewan was denied by the Attorney-General on the grounds that "proclamations are not intended to advance specific policy positions".

We are unsure as to how a Pro-Life Month advances a 'specific policy position' that other proclamations (such as Gender & Sexual Diversity Month, Inclusion Month, Inclusive Education Month, Right to Know Week, Cosmopolitan Day which are only a sample of proclamations approved in 2022) don't.

We will be discussing this further with the Attorney-General and try to get clarification on how respecting human life is viewed as 'advancing a specific policy position'.

Despite the denial of our request, the Saskatchewan Pro-Life Association will proclaim May 2023 as Pro-Life Month. We are having a ceremony to mark this in front of the Legislature on Monday, May 1, 2023, to announce Saskatchewan Pro-Life Month and raise our International Pro-Life Flag. This flag is a recent initiative, a universal effort to which pro-lifers worldwide submitted designs.

As you have indicated to members that you believe in the sanctity of life, we are inviting you to attend this ceremony and would be appreciative of your presence.

Saskatchewan Pro-Life invites you and all the members of your parish to participate in the March for Life on May 11, 2023, commencing at Holy Rosary Cathedral at 2 pm. and ending at the Legislature with a short program. We will be silent witness along Albert Street with a peaceful and powerful demonstration of love and support for the most vulnerable of our citizens. Please feel free to come for the whole afternoon or for whatever portion works best for your students and staff. Please see attached poster for more details.
